## **Instructions for Bottle & Can Drive Fundraiser**

- 1. Print off the number of flyers you want to use in your neighborhood
- 2. Decide when you would like to do your pick-up day and time and fill in the flyer spaces with those dates/pick-up times.

For example, you could input "*Date:* Saturday, July 27" and "*Pick-Up Time:* 3-6 p.m." This way, neighbors will know to either be home during that time or leave their empties outside on the porch for you to pick up. We leave these date/time spaces blank so you can have as much flexibility as possible with scheduling.

3. Leave flyers either in the mailbox or on the front door of neighbors' homes. Generally, you will have best results if you give people about 5-7 days before your pick-up day.

Also, don't forget that especially with summer parties and professional and college sports beginning in the fall, many people create tons of their empties over the weekends!

### **Returning your Cans & Bottles**

Once cans and bottles are collected and returned, the funds raised should go in a sealed envelope with skater's name clearly printed and the words "AFSC Bottle & Can Drive" on the envelope and delivered to the AFSC mailbox near the office. You are welcome to drop off as many envelopes throughout the season as you wish.
